Attorney General Bruning Invites Fellow AGs to Join Fight for Religious Liberty

LINCOLN – Attorney General Jon Bruning today sent a letter to Attorneys General across the United States asking them to join in the effort to file a lawsuit challenging the Obama administration’s decision to force religious organizations to choose between their religious observance and violation of the regulatory mandate.

“As one of the leaders of the constitutional challenge to Obamacare, I’ve spoken with my colleagues to support the efforts of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops and others to stop this unprecedented attack on religious liberty,” said Bruning. “This mandate is yet another example of the federal government overreaching its authority and trampling on the 1st Amendment rights of freedom of speech, religion and association.”
