AG Bruning: Administration's Proposal a False Compromise

LINCOLN – Attorney General Bruning issued the following statement on today's announcement by the Obama administration on the supposed compromise offered on the contraceptive mandate portion of the health care law:

“President Obama's purported ‘compromise’ is, at best, an accounting gimmick,” said Bruning. “The administration's new proposal still tramples on religious freedom by requiring support of activity that violates the conscience and beliefs of millions of Americans.”

The growing coalition of state attorneys general fighting the mandate now stands at 12 including Nebraska, Alabama, Colorado, Florida, Louisiana, Maine, North Dakota, Oklahoma, Ohio, South Carolina, South Dakota and Texas.
